SUBJECT: New Dislocated Worker Rapid Response Funds

The South Central Workforce Council is eligible to receive **\$147,296** in Rapid Response Dislocated worker funding, which is part of **\$1.7 million** being released to WDC's. The purpose for this funding is to increase the number of dislocated workers who receive services and find jobs.

South Central is proposing to increase dislocated worker enrollments by 15 and place 12 of these workers in jobs above its program year 2016 targets and to allocate funds as outlined below.
